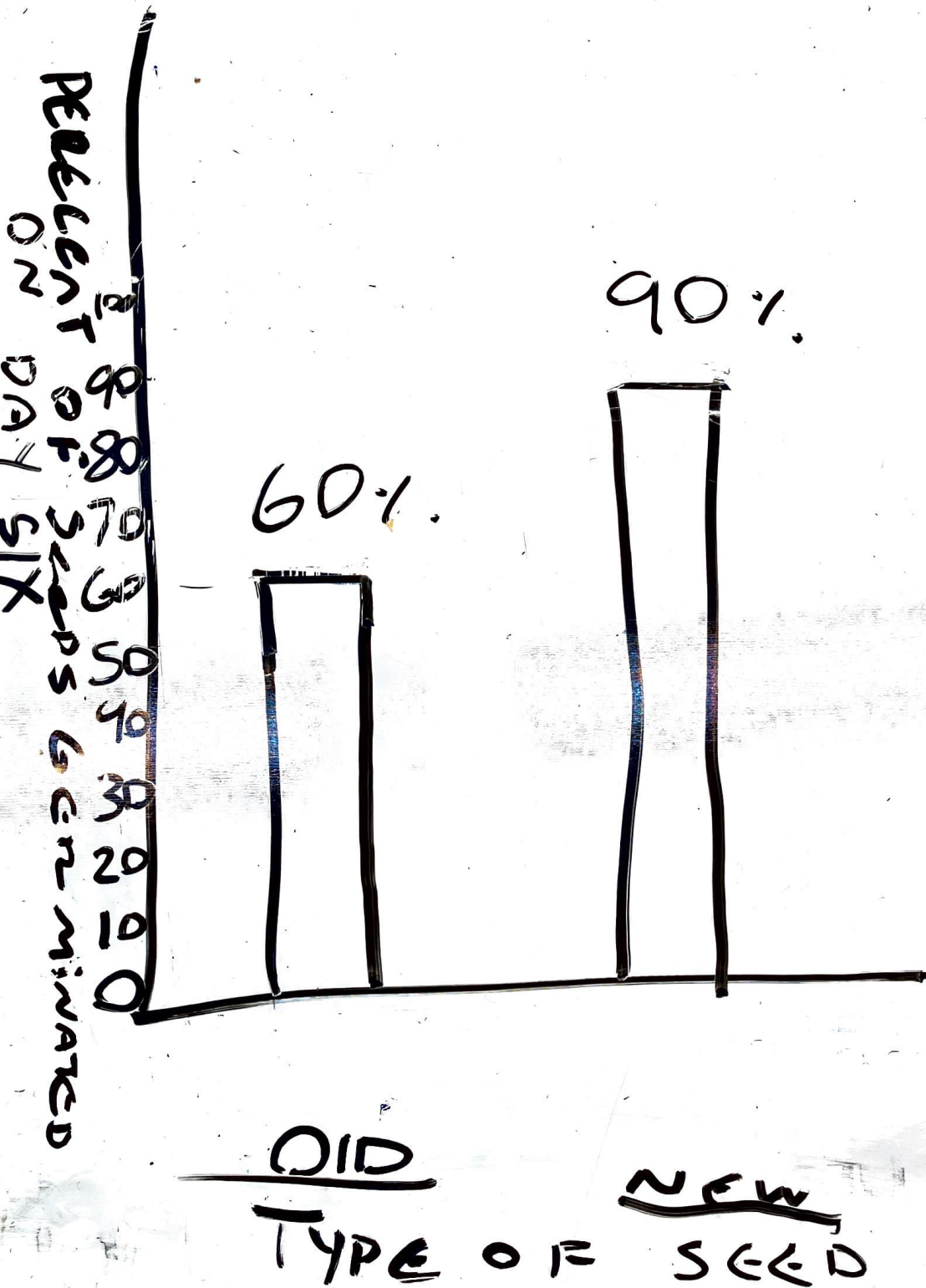
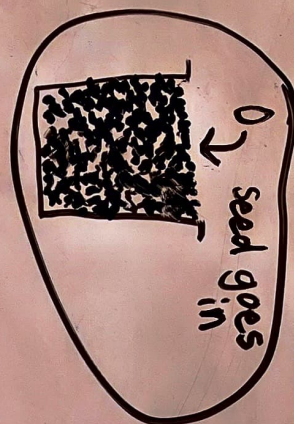


The Effect of a Seed's Age On Germination over a Period of Six Days



Analysis

① We planted our seeds and made sure they were in the right conditions.



② On day 3 we watered each of them with 1 inch of water.



③ On days 4-6, 60% of the old seeds grew and 90% of the new seeds grew.



④ This means that old seeds do in fact take longer than new seeds to germinate.
